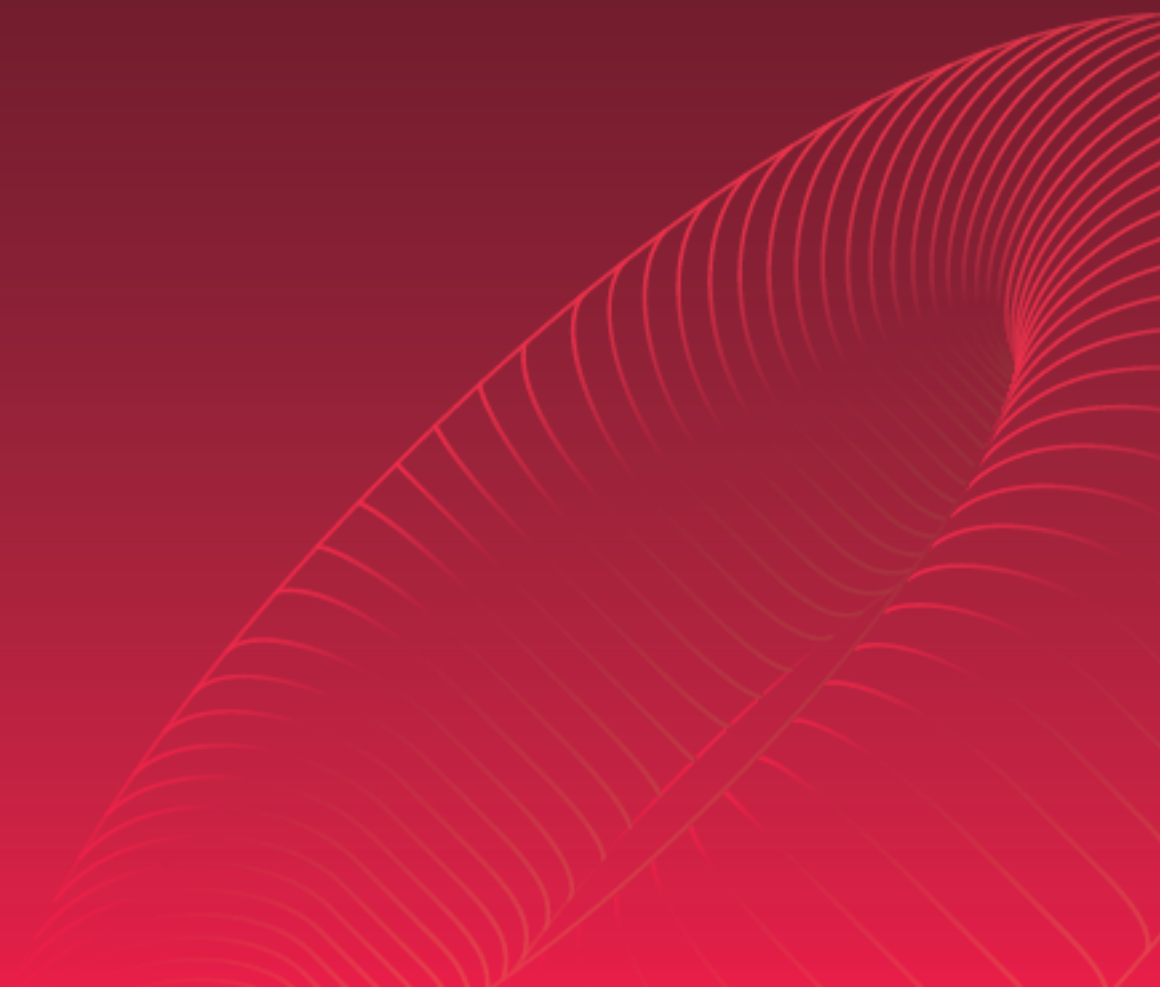

The Company is authorised and regulated by the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission (“CySEC”) as a Cyprus Investment Firm (“CIF”) to offer the services and activities enlisted herein in this document, under the Investment Services and Activities and Regulated Markets Law of 2017 L. 87(I)/2017 (“the Law”).

Investment Services

The Company, as part of its CySEC Authorization may offer the following Investment Services:

- (1) Reception and transmission of orders in relation to one or more Financial Instruments
- (2) Execution of Orders on behalf of Clients
- (3) Dealing on Own Account
- (4) Portfolio Management

Ancillary Services

The Company under its Cyprus Investment Firm's (CIF's) license may offer the following Ancillary Services as well :

- (1) Safekeeping and administration of Financial Instruments for the account of Clients, including custodianship and related services such as cash/collateral management and excluding maintaining securities accounts at the top tier level ("central maintenance service"), as referred to in point 2 of Section A of the Annex to Regulation (EU) No 909/2014.
- (2) Granting credits or loans to an investor to allow him to carry out a transaction in one or more Financial Instruments, where the Firm granting the credit or loan is involved in the transaction.
- (3) Foreign exchange services where these are connected to the provision of investment services.

Financial Instruments

The Company offers the above investment services in relation to certain Financial Instruments, as explained below:

- (1) Transferable Securities.
- (2) Money-market instruments.
- (3) Units in collective investment undertakings.
- (4) Derivative contracts based on securities, currencies, interest rates, yields, emission allowances, or financial indices, settled either physically or in cash
- (5) Cash-settled or optionally cash-settled commodity derivatives, excluding those settled due to default or termination events.
- (6) Physically settled commodity derivatives traded on a regulated market, MTF, or OTF, excluding wholesale energy products on OTFs that must be physically settled
- (7) Physically settled commodity derivatives not for commercial purposes and not covered above, with characteristics of financial instruments
- (8) Derivative instruments for the transfer of credit risk.
- (9) Financial contracts for differences.
- (10) Cash-settled derivatives on climate variables, freight, emissions, inflation, or economic stats, and other similar contracts with financial instrument characteristics, especially if traded on a regulated market or MTF .
